This License Agreement (LICENSE) is a legal agreement between you (either an individual or a single business entity) and the manufacturer, Nonlinear Ideas, Incorporated (NLI) for the software product identified above, which includes computer software, source code, documentation, and associated media (SOFTWARE). By purchasing, installing, and using the SOFTWARE, you agree to be bound by the terms of this LICENSE. If you do not agree to the terms of this LICENSE, do not purchase, install, or use the SOFTWARE.

The SNMP MIB Parser (PARSER) is distributed as a library file for compiling against, and a header file containing definitions of the function interfaces to the library. The SOFTWARE also includes the source code for the SNMP MIB Parser Demo (DEMO CODE) application.

This LICENSE is broken into three sections. The first section, SOFTWARE LICENSE, defines the legal agreements for the entire SOFTWARE distribution, INCLUDING the PARSER and the DEMO CODE. The second section, PARSER LICENSE, defines the legal agreements for the PARSER. The third section, DEMO CODE LICENSE, defines the legal agreements for the DEMO CODE. The SOFTWARE LICENSE agreements

SOFTWARE LICENSE

1. **COPYRIGHT.** The SOFTWARE is owned by NLI and is protected by United States copyright laws and international treaty provisions. Portions of the SOFTWARE copyrighted by other individuals or organizations have separate license agreements.
2. **PROPRIETARY RIGHTS.** All copyright, patents, trade secret, trademarks and other intellectual and property rights in the SOFTWARE are and shall remain the valuable property of NLI. You agree to take all necessary steps to ensure that the provisions of this agreement are not violated by you or by any person under your control or in your service.
3. **EXPORT RESTRICTIONS.** You agree that neither you nor your customers intend to or will, directly or indirectly, export or transmit (a) the SOFTWARE or (b) your APPLICATIONS or service that is the direct product of the SOFTWARE, to any country to which such export or transmission is restricted by any applicable U.S. regulation or statute, without the prior written consent, if required, of the Bureau of

Export Administration of the U.S. Department of Commerce, or such other governmental entity as may have jurisdiction over such export or transmission.

4. MISCELLANEOUS. If you acquired this product in the United States, the laws of the State of Texas govern this LICENSE. If this product was acquired outside the United States, then local law may apply. PARSER LICENSE

1. GRANT OF LICENSE. This LICENSE grants you the following rights and limitations:
 - a. Software Product. NLI grants to you a nonexclusive royalty-free (YES, THAT'S ROYALTY FREE) license to use the PARSER for the sole purposes of designing, developing, and testing your software components or applications (APPLICATIONS).
 - b. You may sell, lease, rent, sublicense, or distribute (i.e. give away) these APPLICATIONS and/or their output, in part or whole, provided:
 - i. The APPLICATION is an executable binary image. [You may NOT, for example, wrap the library with another API and resell it. You may, however, wrap the library with an API so that it can be used in the APPLICATION (e.g. you wrap it with an API to make it accessible by a web server; the web server is your APPLICATION).]
 - ii. A copy of this license agreement is included with all distributions of the APPLICATION where the APPLICATION is physically installed on a customer operated computer.
 - c. You may NOT sell, lease, rent, sublicense, or distribute (i.e. give away) copies of the PARSER, in part or whole. [That is our business model, and our product to sell.]
 - d. You may not reverse engineer, decompile, or disassemble the PARSER.

[For example, you may create an SNMP MIB Browser, which allows your company to parse MIB files, then communicate with SNMP enabled devices, and sell it. Or a tool which parses MIB files and generates output files for use by another tool, and sell it. Or a tool to manage customer networks, and provide the management services to them. The opportunities are yours. We wish you the best of luck.]

DEMO CODE LICENSE

1. GRANT OF LICENSE. This LICENSE grants you the following rights and limitations:
 - a. Source Code. NLI grants you the nonexclusive license to use the DEMO CODE for the sole purpose of designing and developing your software applications (APPLICATIONS) which use the PARSER. The license agreements for these APPLICATIONS are covered in the PARSER LICENSE section of this LICENSE.
 - b. You MAY NOT distribute or disseminate the SOURCE CODE, in whole or in part. [You can't give it away, nor can you post it in news groups or other public media, outside of your company.]
 - c. You MAY sell, rent, lease, or sublicense the application which the SOURCE CODE builds, or derivatives of the application, provided you adhere to the following rules:

- i. If you use ANY GUI ELEMENTS (i.e. resource templates) from the SOURCE CODE, you must prominently (i.e. in the same font, directly below, and clearly visible) the following text wherever your company name is displayed: “THIS PRODUCT DERIVED FROM SOURCE CODE PROVIDED BY Nonlinear Ideas, Inc. (www.nonlinearideas.com)”. [That is to say, if you use our GUI, you have to give us credit. If you don’t use our GUI, then you are not legally bound to credit us in any way, except by including a copy of the license agreement. An endorsement would be nice, but is not required].
- ii. NLI retains the copyrights to the SOURCE CODE only. You are free to copyright the derived code. [We wrote it, but you spent time and effort to make it “better”, or at least different. You deserve credit for that.]
